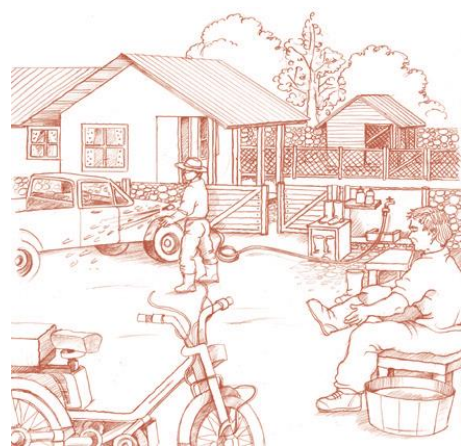
...the things we do at our farm to prevent disease from entering or spreading.

A BIOSECURITY SYSTEM FOR BACKYARD CHICKENS



Bury dead chickens with white lime before covering with earth.

Use clean footwear dedicated for the chicken area.



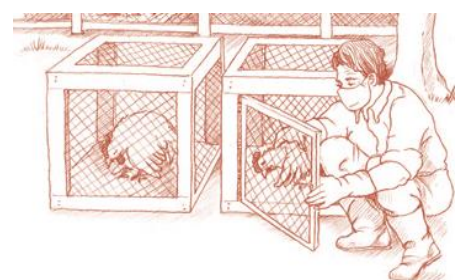
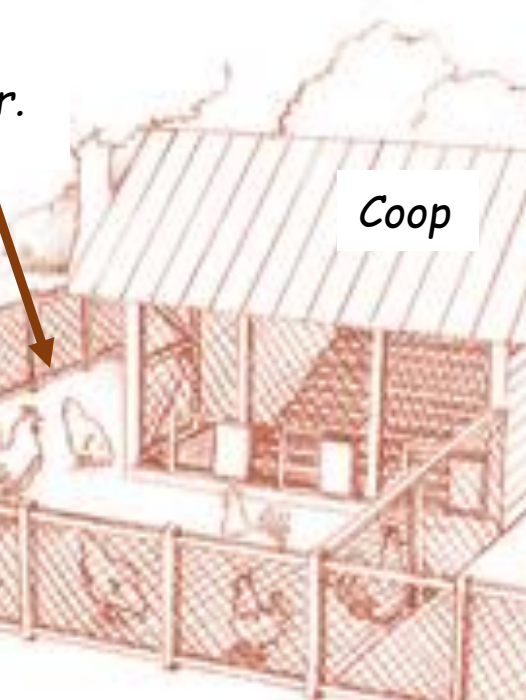
Restrict access for people and vehicles.

Chickens, feed and clean water.

Secure fence.



Put up a biosecurity sign



Remove sick chickens and keep separate from main flock.



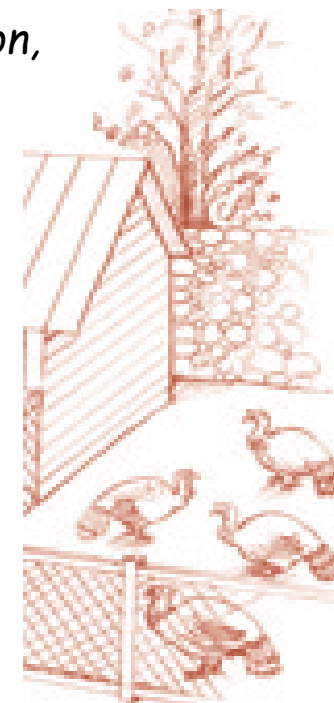
Always wash hands before and after handling chickens.



Quarantine new chickens at a separate location.



Vaccinate your flocks against diseases like Newcastle Disease.



Keep different types of poultry separate.

Keep records of important events (e.g. debeaking, vaccination, deworming).
